At home in Swindon, former home of the "Great Western" Railway and in the industrial heart of England, "Rocket Bob" Pete Pearson has made himself a name for extraordinary handcrafted and creative customs in a very short time: Founded in 2009, his bikes had success in many bike shows around the globe and he is creating extraordinary motorcycles almost from scratch. Such as "Speed Weevil" a purpose-built 250 cc Triumph engined racer which is built for one purpose: To race at the Bonneville Salt Flats!

With the exception of the basic engine completely handcrafted, Pete is sure getting a record when ever he is riding his bike onto the salt. He has simply created a motorcycle of a new class that has never been tried before. While there were Super-











charged and Turbo-charged motorcycles of this displacement class racing at Bonneville, his bike features both: At the same time!

Rolling chassis, fork and swingarm are all handcrafted to perfection, all nuts and bolts already secured to meet the homologation requirements of Tech inspection at the Motorcycle Speed Trials, again to be held end of August 2017. Fuel tank allows a possible 15 miles "round trip" at Bonneville – and the bet is that he will extend that, after he heard about the cues at the fuel station! Bob also has fenders on "standby" for the conditions on the salt, but "I wanted to show the technology and the ideas which went into the design and construction of this racebike", states Pete. And the overwhelming amount of votes he received from this years MBE Jury confirmed this nicely!

The rigid WLA frame is smoothened and the tank has been perfectly matched to the frame lines, integrating the ignition coil to the right tank half. Handcrafted exhaust pipe and numerous details make this bike a true winner!

Sidestand is mounted to the right – exhaust side – which alters the look of the motorcycle again. Open carb and equally "hot" exhaust pipes are more race-style than the license plate indicates...

Can anybody have too much custom? A question that might be answered one day at the MOTOR BIKE EXPO in Verona. This year is event was absolutely packed with custombikes of all styles and it became almost impossible to see all of them! Not just because of the crowds that storm the event on every single one of the 3 show days, but also because of the outstanding creativity and quality of the bikes exhibited. Again, the MBE team added more "thrill" and as much "custom" as possible into this already popular custom-bike event. Showtime in Verona is always a special date in the calendar, as Italian builders create some of the most unique machines in Europe – and they are the first to present them to international press and the public every new year! The Custom Chrome International Bike Show Series teamed up with Italy is biggest Custom-Motorcycle Show in 2012 for an exciting Italian Championship and renewed their task again for 2017! As a sponsor for various Bike Shows during the Bike Expois history, Custom Chrome Europe had always donated valuable prizes in the past – since 2012 the entire event at Verona has become a part of the Custom Chrome International Bike Show Series – and in 2017 MBE had asked to introduce a FXR class for the bike show. With freezing temperatures even south of the Alps, the annual MOTOR BIKE EXPO in Verona comes prepared: The visitors know the drill and they rather have cold weather and sunshine – as it happened for three days in a row – than warm weather and rainy drizzle. The massive number of visitors never fail to impress exhibitors and participants of the shows – Verona MOTOR BIKE EXPO is the place to be in January!

Custom Chrome Europe has always recognized the importance of this season-opening event which is the top showcase to introduce new parts, new ideas and – of course – new bikes! This year, Master Builder Fred Kodlin promised to have his entry into the "Bolt On and Ride" Motorcycles ready by January – just in time for a Premiere at MOTOR BIKE EXPO. And he delivered! The 2017 catalogue in the final stages at this time of the year, Verona is the place to see the new parts already – and maybe use them in the next project, since on the north side of the alps, riding season is still about two months away, if not longer!

Following "Best of Show" at Custombike, he won 2nd Championship at MOTOR BIKE EXPO and the prestigious Willie G. Davidson Design Award, handed out by Karen Davidson! Lot^B of design parts and modifications on what was a stock frame once. Third place in Championship class went to Barcelona for a Ironhead "Bonsai" bike which combined the old Sportster engine with a automatic Yamaha Scooter transmission in a hand build frame. Would you believe that a Sportster can be built that small?

Graced by superb weather, MOTOR BIKE EXPO again attracted huge crowds – claims are 160.000 – and a lot of the important South European custombike dealers from France and even Spain attend or visit this important event. Verona 2017 again lived up to previous standards with superb and extraordinary custom motorcycles – and the nomination of the Custombikes for the CCE/MBE Show was as difficult as ever, if not more! The introduction of a new class "FXRs of Verona" for FXR and Dyna based Custombikes was challenging. Highlighting the rubber-mounted "naked" Big Twin Models of Harley-Davidson from 1982 to now, the Custom Chrome International Bike Show Series Italian Championship added the "FXRs of Verona" class for the 2017 event. US-based FXR specialist Kirk Taylor and Swiss international Customizer Danny Schneider who tried bringing toge-ther as many European and International modified and customized FXR

and Dyna motorcycles as possible while the CCE Bike Show Team had the bikes then judged by national and international magazines and international builders, to get the best bikes of Verona awarded. Which turned out to be Danny Schneider own "7.0 FXR\$" he created as his daily rider and "showcase" for his future engagement in the FXR business.

When in 2015 the Café Racer/Dirt Track Style motorcycles moved from hall 1 to occupy a major portion of hall 4 nobody expected that this would soon occupy the complete hall and expand the show even further. But the Scrambler and Café Racer fraction has become stronger and stronger in the last years – including own magazines and bike presentations in hall 4. Hall 1 remained home of the "Low Ride" Bikeshow and International exhibitors including the Legendary "Buffalo Chip" Campground of Sturgis and Perewitz, this time represented by daughter Jody who continued the "Perewitz Paint Show" pick for the "Motor Bike Expo" audience and exhibitors, adding another cool "customizing theme" to an already busy "trophy Sunday". 2017 Winner was well known Boguslaw Malajowicz of Maly HD fame from Poland with his completely handcrafted "Avatar" Chopper scoring again!

All major shows have now extended their "nominees" to the bikes exhibited on the booths, but the massive \in 10.000,-- in CCE parts are a huge argument for CCEI3 show anyway. "The Custom Chrome International Bike Show Series is created to allow the bike builders to win trophies, valuable vouchers for CCE parts – and get more international recognition for the Italian builders", adds Scholz, "we recognize and value the creativity and diversity of the Italian builders, that have also made a great impact in the pages of our catalogue, now distributing their parts all over the world. "The

68 nominated bikes out of a number of probably 500+ possible custombikes at this event were nominated and marked with special Custom Chrome International Bike Show Series markers, from which a selected international panel of judges, including Kirk Taylor, Cory Ness and international journalists selected the winners. Additional to the established Championship Class, Modified Harley Class, RevTech Performance Class and Jammer Old School Class, all of which were awarded 1st-3rd place not only with trophies but also with CCE sales credit vouchers for a total of € 10.000,--, CCE introduced the "FXRs of Verona".

Custom Chrome Europel 2017 "Bolt On and Ride" bikes are currently "under construction" at another 4 different German top-customizers, detail pre-

views can be seen on the www.Custom-Chrome-Europe.com homepage and CCEB Facebook site.

Parts of the upcoming 47th catalogue edition were already on display, while the 46th catalogue was still sold at the event! CCE stays focused on the Italian market, looking for new trends and parts with a considerable number of staff: "We see this as a win-win situation for both, the Custom Chrome International Bike Show Series and the Motor Bike Expo", says Scholz, "Italy stays one of the big markets for customizing – In the last years, great custom-built motorcycles were built here. And we still have some ideas for the Italian market!"

Parts t fit booth type of motorcycles are currently created worldwide, but Italian manufacturers have a word too. 2nd place went to Ottodicuorils 2016 introduced ODC/Crusher Dyna FXDX which meanwhile has received another upgrade with a fitting FXRT fairing in complete carbon-fiber look. Fork and rear suspension are ODC parts, as well as grips and indicators.

Another entry to the field received 3rd place with the original FXRT setup, now fully – including fenders, tank, tank dash and fairing components – in carbon! TCB Carbon Parts Italy had several FXRIs on the display booth, but the FXRT won!

JUDGING PROCEDURE VERONA 2017:

To make judging easy under very crowded show conditions, we have pre-selected and NOMINATED the bikes pictured with RIGHT and LEFT view in this judging sheet. As usual for the MOTOR BIKE EXPO VERONA, we picked the competing bikes out of ALL BIKES EXHIBITED in Verona, no matter if at any given BIKE SHOW or at the Vendors/Manufacturers Displays. The Location of the bike is given in the caption and in the accompanying hall floor plan. Each bike can/should be identified by a "MOTOR BIKE EXPO/Custom Chrome Europe International Bike Show Series NOMINATED BIKE" sign.

CLASS DEFINITIONS: RevTech Performance Class

The RevTech Performance Class is for bikes built around any platform of RevTech motor. Any modification can be made to frame, motor, sheet metal or components in the RevTech Performance Class. Use of aftermarket or custom parts is acceptable. The bike must be entered by the builder.

Modified Harley Class

In the Modified Harley class the frame and motor must be original equipment from Harley-Davidson. This includes all Screamin' Eagle and special equipped bikes from the factory or any year or model. Any modification may be made to the frame, motor or sheet metal. The engine cases must remain original equipment, however any modification to the cylinders and heads may be made. Use of aftermarket or custom parts is acceptable. The bike must be entered by the builder.

Championship Class

The Championship Class is the premier class at all Custom Chrome International Bike Show Series events. This class features one off custom bikes, with no strings or rules of design attached. There are no limitations or structure of the entries in this class. The Championship Class is a showcase for true fusion design where the motorcycle builders are free to explore and push the boundaries of what makes a custom motorcycle. The bike must be entered by the builder.

Jammer Old School Class

The Jammer Old School Class is for bikes that represent the retro and old school lifestyle. The Jammer Old School Class is focused on bikes built with retro styling and motors. Any frame or drivetrain may be used that keeps the Old School theme to the bike. Motors should be of vintage or retro style platform. Any fabrication is acceptable to the motor, frame, sheet metal or components. Use of aftermarket or custom parts is acceptable in the Original Old School Class. The bike must be entered by the builder.

All FXR / Dyna rubbermounted frame based Harley-Davidson's - Custom, modified and (restored) stock.
